**PREREQUISITE:** Successful completion of French 1, 2, 3, 4, 5 and 6.

**COREQUISITES:** If you take AP FRENCH 7 (FALL), you must also take AP FRENCH 8 (SPRING).

## **AP FRENCH 8 (SPRING)**

**PREREQUISITE:** Credit in Spanish 3 and 4 or (Spanish for Spanish Speakers 3 and 4) or teacher recommendation.

**COREQUISITES:** If you take AP SPANISH LANGUAGE (FALL), you must also take AP SPANISH LANGUAGE (SPRING).

### **SPANISH FOR SPANISH SPEAKERS 4 (SPRING)**
