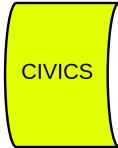
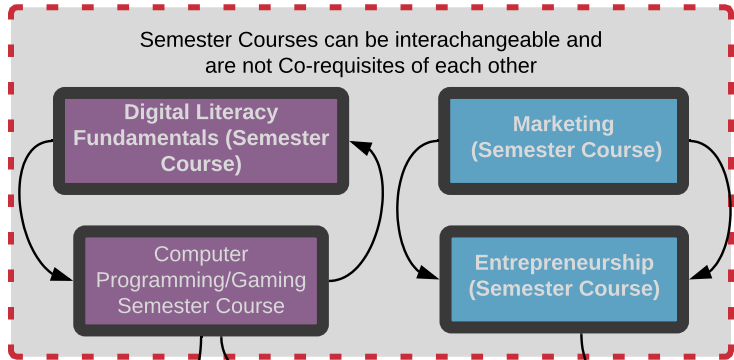
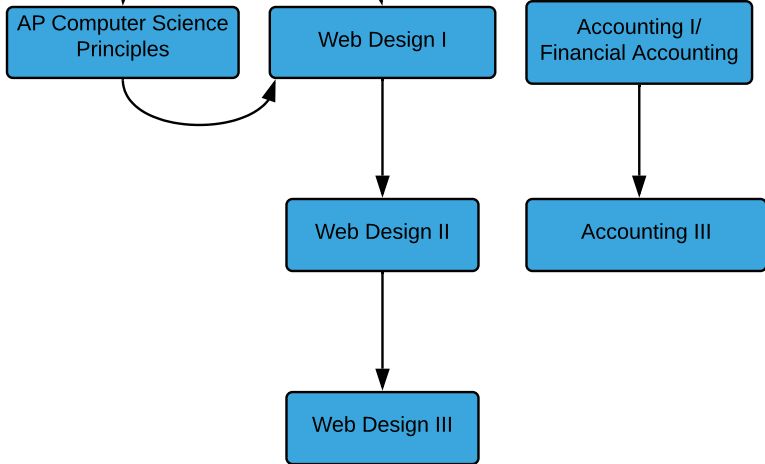


Business Education



Digital Literacy:
 Dual Credit course prepares students to use technology in a proficient and responsible manner in school, in the workforce, and in everyday life. Students will be provided with the opportunity to seek industry-recognized digital literacy certifications. Topics include the benefits and risks of sharing information online, and the possible consequences of inappropriate sharing (oversharing). Students explore the legal and ethical dimensions of respecting creative work. Technology use is a vital employability skill for entry-level and upper-level management positions.
