

Linking Khan Academy with College Board

1. Go to khanacademy.org/sat

- Click on “Start Practicing”
- If you already have an account, select ***Already Have an Account?***, then sign in.

*** If you see the statement ***You are connected to CollegeBoard.org*** toward the middle/left of your screen, your accounts are already linked and you do not need to complete any additional steps ***



- If you do not already have an account, create one using an email address you use regularly

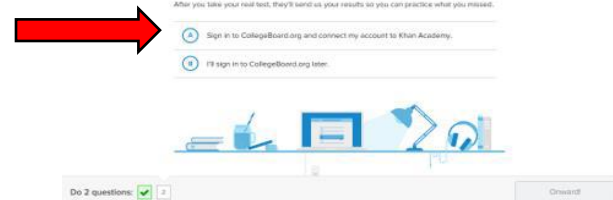
2. Question 1:

- Select **“A”** if you have already taken the SAT, PSAT/NMSQT, PSAT 10 or PSAT 8/9 during high school ****should be almost all District 201***
- Select **“B”** if you have not. Then select “Next to question 2”



3. Question 2:

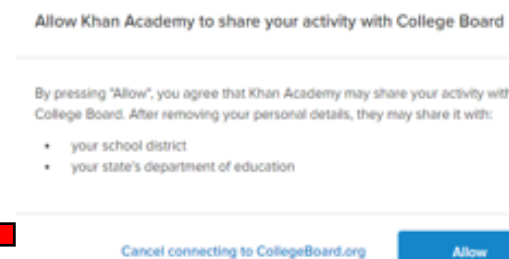
- Select **“A”** to sign into your College Board account
- Then select **“Onward!”**



4. Sign into your College Board account and confirm your information

- If you cannot remember your username or password, use the ***forgot username or password*** option
- If you attempt to recover both your username and password but College Board still cannot find you, CREATE a College Board account. Make sure you use an email address that you check regularly!



5. Connect Khan with College Board. Click **“Send”**, then click **“Allow”**





- * Note: School day SAT/PSAT includes essay section


